Eligibility

Chinese wushu associations, martial arts schools, other social martial arts organizations and individuals from all over the world can register for the competition.

Guide

- 1.This competition includes individual and group competition events, plus group demonstrations.
- 2.The Taolu competition will be carried out in accordance with the "1999 International Wushu Federation Rules" For more information about these rules, please visit: ww.wushu.com.cn

Item

Schedule

- 1、 Individual Wushu Items : no more than 2 mins.
- 2、 Taichi Taolu: no more than 4 mins, the Chief referee will whistle for reminding at the last minute.
- 3、 Taichi weapons , Mulan Boxing, Mulan Instrument, Taichi Soft Ball: No more than 3 minutes, the Chief referee will whistle for reminding at the last minute.
- 4、 Group Items:
Minimum of 6 participants for Wushu Taolu and Fitness Qigong. The requirement for performing time: not more than 5 minutes, music must accompany the performance and provided by the group

leader. If not provided, 0.1 points will be deducted. Rap music is not allowed. The coach or team leader of the team is responsible for playing the music. Health Qigong: no more than 6 minutes, music must be provided (with no spoken instructions)

5. All items must be performed in accordance with the prescribed routines. Actions adding or cutting are not allowed. No points deducted if routines are not completed within the time allocated.

Arbitration Commission

1. The composition and scope of duties of the Arbitration Commission shall be implemented in accordance with the Regulations of the Arbitration Commission and shall be uniformly selected by the Organizing Committee.
2. Referees are selected by the organizing committee, the referees need to bring their own black referee clothing and black shoes.

Award Levels

A/ The awards for Wushu Taolu Items.

(1) Individual Items: 30% for the First Prize, 40% for the Second prize, respectively, by group, event, male and female. The number of winners is based on the actual number of participants and is rounded off. Individual events with less than 6 participants will be added to other groups or other boxing competitions. The First three winners will be awarded with medal and certificate of the Champion, the Runner-up and the third-prize, and the rest will be awarded with certificate of the Commemorative Prize.

(2) Group Items: no age limit. To encourage greater participation, event winners will be decided on performance points multiplied by the number of people in the group. Awards will be similar to the Individual event.

B/ Elite (Over-All Champion) Selection(Award calculations refer to Schedule 5:)

1. Admission conditions and reward methods for individual martial arts routines: (please refer to Schedule 5)

All-round athletes must participate in barehand and weapon events, with a minimum of three individual items for consideration in the over-all champion evaluation.

C/ Elite Group Awards (entry method and rules for groups are available in schedule 5:)

The elite group award categories are as follows:

- 1·martial arts
- 2·square dance
- 3.Aerobics
- 4·Chinese cheongsam show class

Registration

1. The deadline for registration is 31/07/2019

2. Martial arts lovers from all over the world can participate in the competition, and can participate in the name of sponsoring enterprises (except tobacco and alcohol companies).
3. Each athlete in Taolu competition is limited to 3 (barehand and weapon items).
4. Each representative team is limited to one group event. The number of people must not be less than 6 (including 6), gender and age can be mixed.
5. Individual competitors will be divided by age for Taolu (refer to the age item classification table)
6. When the barehand and weapons are less than 6 persons, they will be re-arranged into adjacent groups or other boxing competitions.
7. After the registration deadline, if you are unable to participate in the competition for any reason, the registration fee will not be refunded, and the other fees will be refunded in full. All fees will not be refunded after 15/08/2019.
8. In order to ensure the order of the competition, the application for change of the competition items is subject to a written application, the signature of the team leader and AUS \$50 charge will be needed.
9. In order to ensure the smooth progress of the competition, the organizing committee will send the confirmation form back to the team after receiving the registration form; please check it carefully, make sure everything correct, then sign and return it to organizing committee. The default of the team information is correct if the team leader did not return the form within 2 days of receiving.

Rules

For registration form and entry rules, articles of association and entries and age group table, please check in attachments from 1-5.

Competition rules

1. Time and location for check in:
 - (a) All national referees need to check in time between 9.00 am to 4.00 pm. 30/08/ 2019
 - (b) All national team leaders and coaches have to attend the organizing committee and technical meetings on time, at 6:30 pm 30/08/ 2019.
 - (c) All participating athletes need to check in between 9:00 am-4.00Pm, 30/08/ 2019. (Domestic athletes can make appointments for check in by phone if they can't check in on the same day) to receive admission badge. Team leaders may register on behalf of all team members.
 - (d) Check-in location: 851 Whitehorse Road, Box Hill, Victoria, Australian
2. All participating athletes are required to purchase the Personal Accident Insurance for the duration of the competition 30/08/2019--01/09/2019.
3. After check in, please read the contents of the order book carefully. If there is any objection to the event or name, please be sure to fill in the application form and sign the report to the organizing committee by the team leader or coach before 5:00 pm on 30/08/2019 (specify the signatory's contact number). The organizing committee will check for it and the final result will be based on the original registration form.
4. No entries will be changed if there are no programming errors.

5. Athletes must check-in 30 minutes before the competition. They need to wait at the check-in office before going to the game. If the athletes don't go for competition after the name is called for three times, they will be treated as abstaining.
6. Athletes must wear martial arts clothing and martial arts shoes. Clothing and Weapons need to be prepared by yourself..
7. The right to interpret the above clauses belongs to The Committee of Australian International Martial Arts Festival and the Committee has the right to use the portraits of participants in each activity.
8. Matters not covered, further notice.

Registration method

Fee collection standard and registration deadline:

- 1, reporting expenses: \$50 / person (all athletes who participate in this competition will have to pay entry fee for the attendees on the team.)
2. Individual event costs: \$50 / item, Group: \$20 / person
3. More than 30 athletes will be exempt from group competition fees (that is, \$20 / entry fee waived)
- 4、 Registration deadline: 31/07/2019

Note items:

- 1, all participation expenses must be submitted before registration. And write the transfer certificate number on the registration form, or send it to the Liaison Office designated by the Competition Committee with a photocopy of the photo document.
